Remark	Sensitizer. As a general rule, the SCOEL committee does not recommend health-based OELs for sensitizers, as no threshold can be identified. However, in view of the large number of workers exposed and the relatively large data base, SCOEL recognizes that exposures ≤ 1 mg/m ³ of inhalable flour dust would protect the majority of exposed workers from the onset of disease and that the envisaged symptoms would be mild. However, concentrations < 1 mg/m ³ may trigger symptoms in already sensitized workers. As an OEL that protects all workers cannot be identified, it would be advisable to routinely apply good practices and health surveillance systems to bakery and mill environments.
