PRECAUTIONS: Store in original container, tightly closed, in a safe place away from children and foodstuffs. Avoid all contact by mouth and eyes. Wear waterproof gloves when handling bait or dead rodents. Wash hands after use and any exposed skin before meals, smoking or rest breaks. Prevent access to baits by children and domestic animals, particularly cats, dogs, pigs and birds. Do not use where food or feed could become contaminated. Retrieve and burn or bury all rodent bodies, unused baits and bait containers after treatment.

FIRST AID: If swallowed do NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poison Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately. If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. If splashed in eyes, wash out immediately with water.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: For use in bait stations only. Apply 6-8g (2 teaspoons) of bait to the base of a fully enclosed waxed bait box. Place boxes containing bait in areas where rodents are suspected but where bait station will be inaccessible to children or domestic animals. Do not place near hot pipes, ovens etc. Inspect baiting points frequently and replace bait until no more is taken. By law, this product must only be used as specified in the label.

SHELF LIFE: When stored appropriately, this product should show no significant degradation for 2 years from the date of manufacture. Contact your supplier for further information about the use of any product that is older than this.
