DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Situations	Rates	Critical Comments
Industrial and Commercial areas including food areas. Domestic Pest Control, including homes and shops Vector Control Grain Silos, Shipping Holds and Containers.	Use 200mL Fog-It plus the appropriate amount of other active product for 1000m ³ of space for four hours then vent.	Place warning signs outside all entrances to fogged areas. Work away from generated fog not into or towards fog. Always work towards a planned exit.

Important - Food contamination

1. Fog-It is a fogging agent that may be used in all areas as a carrier for approved compounds.
2. Before use, all exposed food and packaging material must be removed from the room.
3. Cover all food surface areas and plastic surfaces which may be affected by contact with chemical.
4. After use, food areas must be adequately ventilated and food contact surfaces must be rinsed with potable water.
